

Supplemental Education Services (SES) Information

Per NCLB regulations, students from low-income families attending Title I schools in their second year of school improvement (i.e. Schools that have not made Adequate Yearly Progress – AYP, for three or more years), corrective action, or restructuring status are eligible to receive Supplemental Educational Services, such as after – school tutoring. Supplemental Education Services are being offered during the 2009-10 school year to Southwick Tolland RSD elementary and middle school students from low income families. These services are provided in the student's school, home or community center.
